1. If the verb ends with " $y$ ", we change it to -i and add -ed :

- Try - tried
- spy - spied

2. If the verb ends with "e", we add just a "d" (not "ed"):

- closed - closed (NOT: closeed)
- measure - measured

3. Double the final consonant if the verb ends in a (CVC)*:

- plan - planned
- stop - stopped
