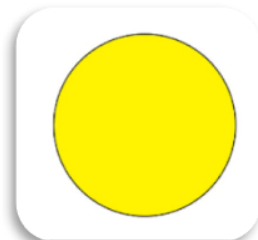

Spelling changes with past simple

1. If the **verb ends with "y"**, we change it to **-i** and add **-ed** :
 - Try — tried
 - spy — spied
2. If the **verb ends with "e"** , we add just a **"d"** (not "ed"):
 - closed — closed (NOT: closeed)
 - measure — measured
3. **Double the final consonant** if the verb ends in a (CVC)*:
 - plan — planned
 - stop — stopped


