# COMPARING ADVERBS & ADJECTIVES



The most common way to compare things is to add—er or —est to the adjective or adverb.

#### EXCEPTION: Use more or most when comparing

- adjectives with three or more syllables (more responsible, most responsible)
- adverbs that end in -ly (more loudly, most loudly)


