### **Arabian** wolves

Most people are very scared of wolves. In the Middle East, all the wolves might die, as well as in many other parts of the world. Scientists think there are only between 1000 and 2000 wolves left in countries like Syria, Lebanon, Oman and Saudi Arabia, which is different from before.

Sometime before the 1970s, the Arabian wolf lived along the sandy dunes of the United Arab Emirates, but not now. It ate birds, insects, sheep and goats.
