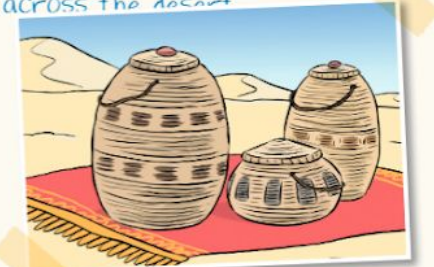
A proud memory

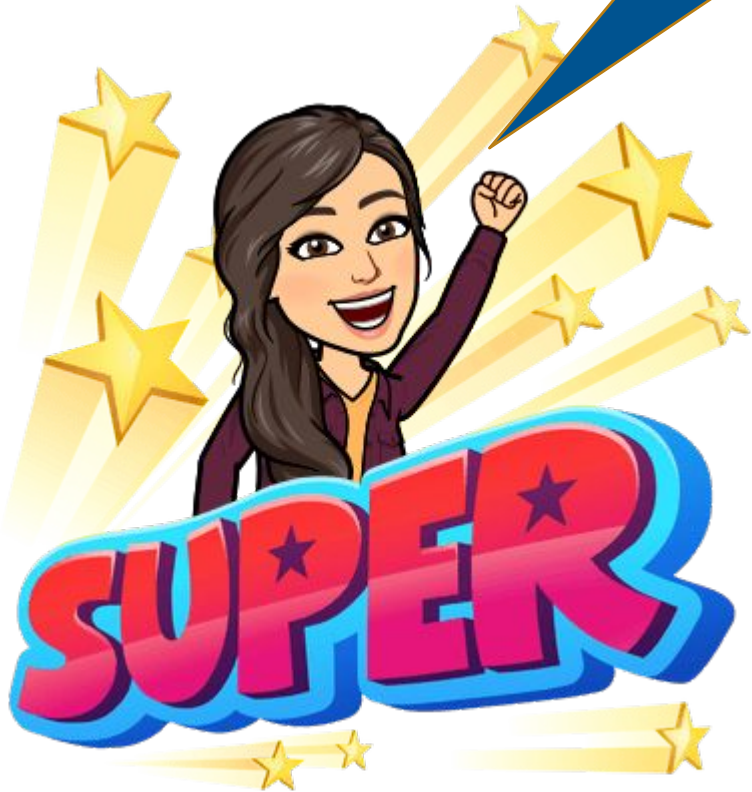
