The Ghaf tree lives in the dessert where the climate is dry and hot winds.

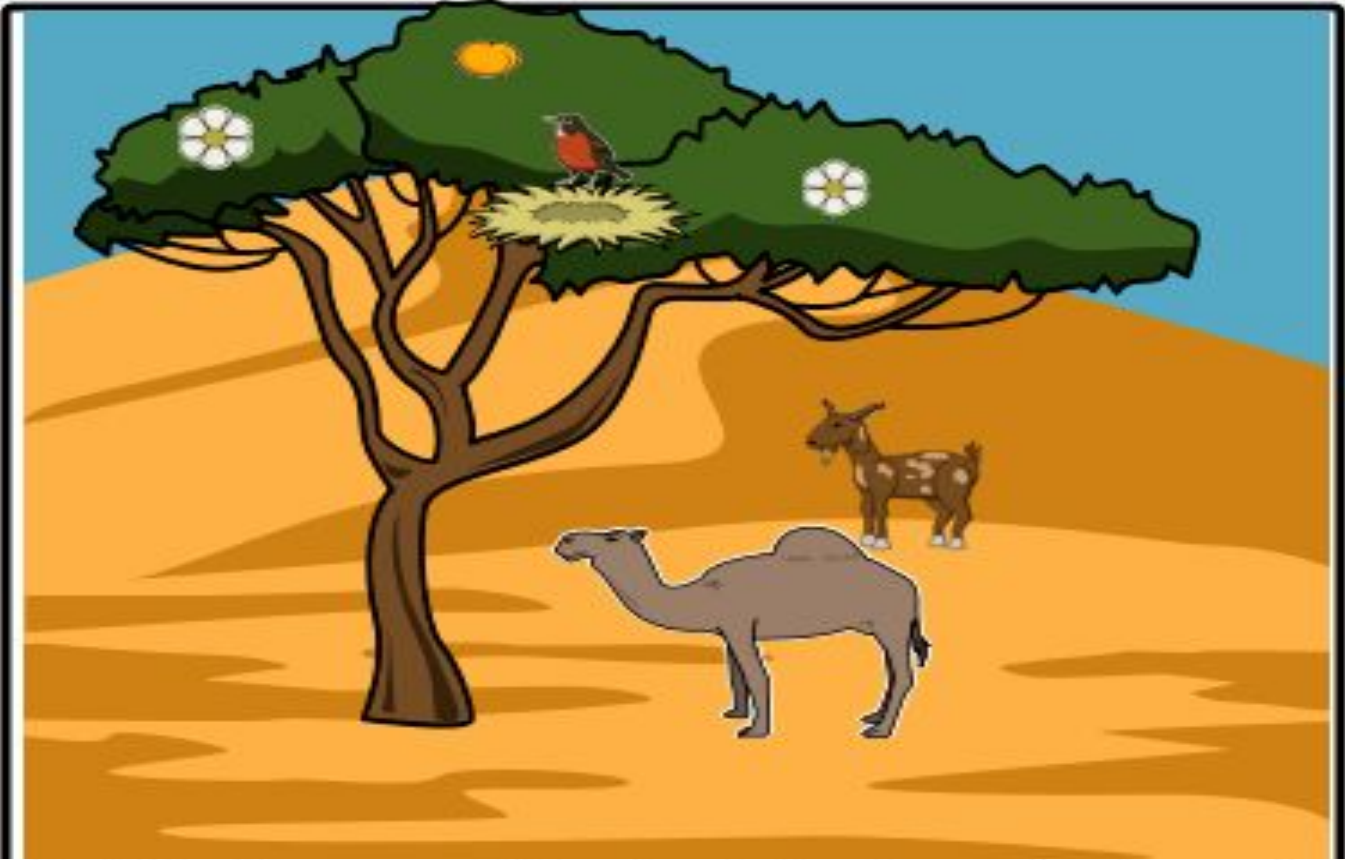
Is the Ghaf tree the national tree of the UAE?



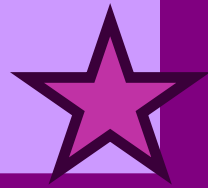
Yes, the Ghaf tree was declared the national tree of the UAE in 2008.

The Ghaf tree provides shade for the animals, nests for birds and flowers and fruits for birds and animals.



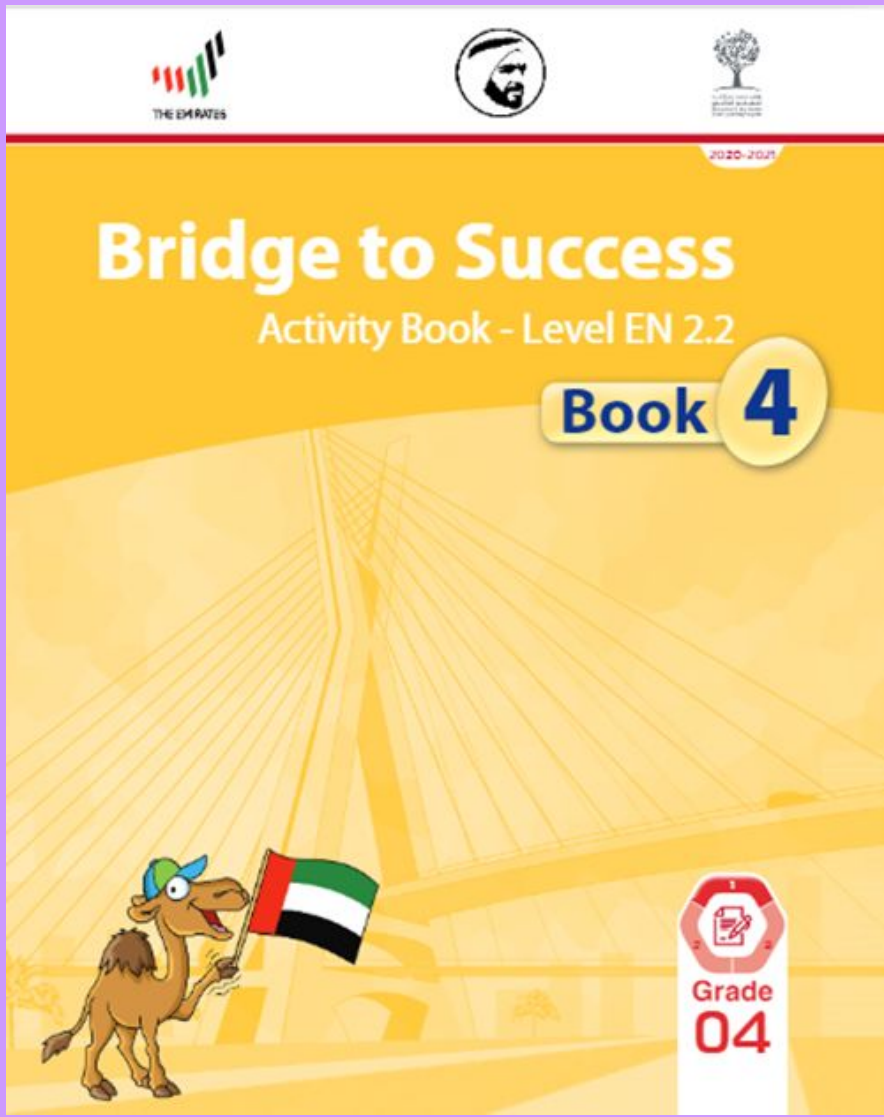

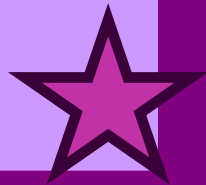

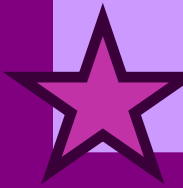
