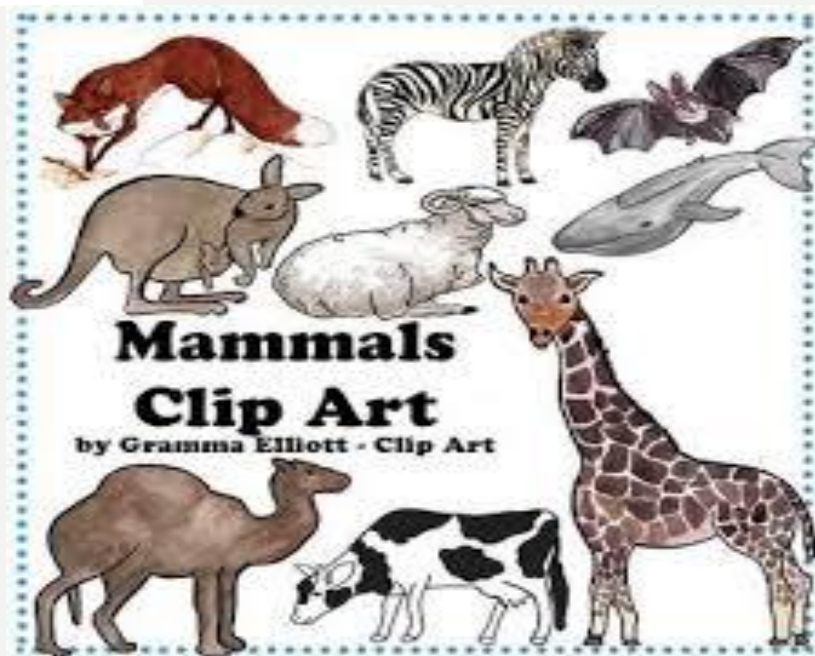

celebrate

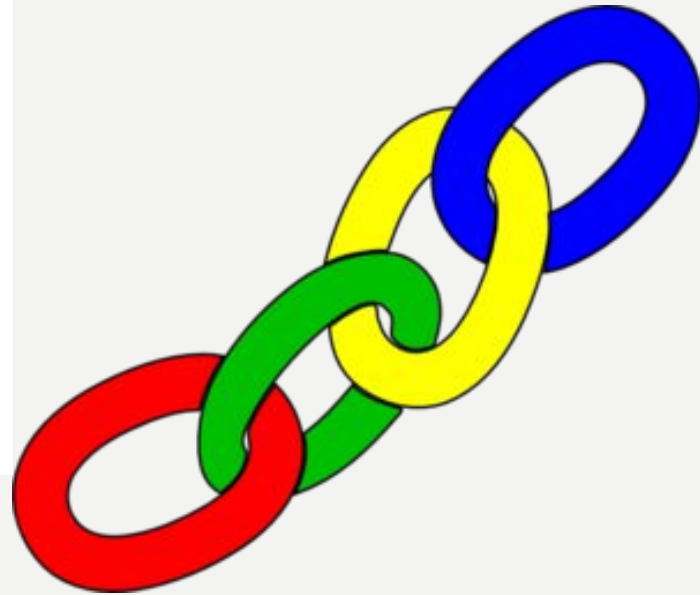

string.



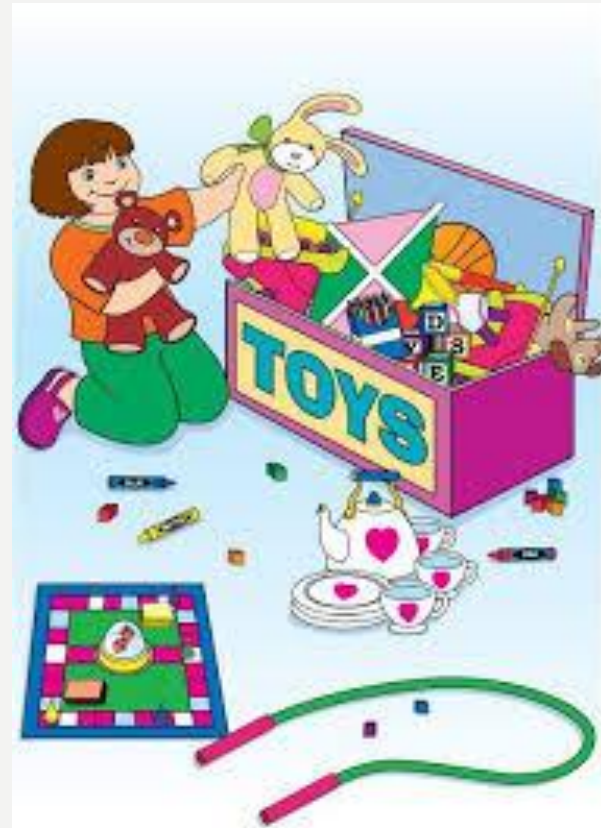
cross
